

Please consider signing the request for the DEC to provide a supplemental environmental impact statement on the 1100MW Cricket Valley power plant. It will generate between 6 and 16 million metric tons CO2E annually, as well as toxic VOCs and smog-forming nitrogen oxide. About 800 children go to school within a mile of the plant. 1400 students attend schools within 5 miles.

The original EIS was done in 2011... before the state moratorium on fracking; before recent IPCC, COP, and US government reports on climate change; before state pledges to cut GHG emissions and deploy renewables.
