We did gain a few insights and now have a date to hear the merits of our Article 78 suit against the DEC and Cargill.

There we will hear the technical arguments on all sides and the judge will see how there is CERTAINLY the POTENTIAL for significant environmental impacts from drilling a 2400 ft deep, 18 ft wide shaft into the ground which connects to a vast salt mine under one of the finger lakes.
