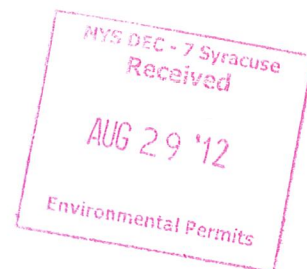

Cargill Deicing Technology business unit of Cargill, Incorporated is submitting a Mined Land Reclamation Permit Renewal Application to extend the existing permit for another 5 year term. The necessary Application Form, maps and other materials are attached here. Mining will continue as described in the Mined Land Use Plan dated December 22, 2000.

The surface lands owned by Cargill comprise 260.04 acres, of which 67.67 acres were disturbed in constructing the facility over the past 97 years. No new lands have been disturbed since the last permit renewal.

No lands have been reclaimed since 1975, or since the last permit renewal. Further, no land reclamation is anticipated during the upcoming permit term since all the surface facilities will continue to be utilized. Reclamation efforts, when they do begin in the future, will be carried out as described in section 2.6.4 and 2.6.4.1 (pages 79 and 80) in the Mined Land Use Plan dated December 22, 2000.

The mine maps included here show the underground mine on the #6 level, where mining is taking place. The large map shows what has been mined underground during the past 5 years (the last permit term), as well as the anticipated underground mining to be done during the upcoming permit term (January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2017). Two enlargements of the northern and southern mining areas are included to better show the mining activity.

The Reclamation Bond payment will be made as soon as the new amount is determined.

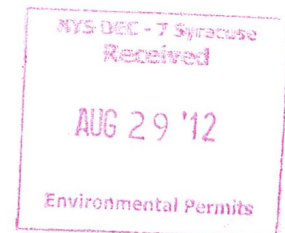
The cover page for Cargill's New York State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit (SPDES) is included for your records. This permit expires on July 1 of 2013.
